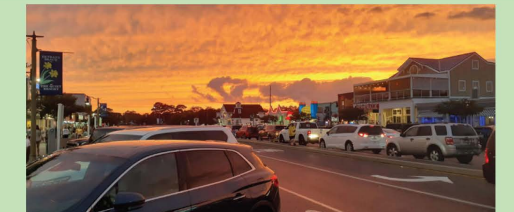

Good To Know

Handicap Wheelchairs: Bethany Beach has 2 specially made wheelchairs capable of maneuvering in the sand. They are available from 15 May through 15 September from 9:30am to 5pm, at no cost. They are first come first serve and located by the Lifeguard Station. Please call 302-539-1000 to borrow one.

Public Restrooms: Public restroom facilities are located below the Lifeguard Station. Additional temporary restrooms are emplaced at several beach parking lots during the summer season.

BICYCLE RULES & SAFETY

Bicyclists Must Not:

- Operate or ride upon a bicycle under the age of 16 without wearing a helmet.
- Ride upon a bicycle while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed except that an adult rider may carry a child securely attached to the person in a backpack or sling.
- Cling to or be attached to a motor vehicle.
- Ride upon a bicycle without at least one hand on the handlebars.
- Ride a bicycle while wearing earplugs or a headset.
- Fail to stop at a stop sign or obey a traffic control device.
- Engage in a bicycle race.
- Ride a bicycle at night that does not have a white lamp on the front capable of emitting a light that can be seen 500 feet to the front and does not have a red light or reflector on the rear that can not be seen from a distance of 600 feet.
- Ride a bicycle on a sidewalk.
- Ride a bicycle without yielding to pedestrians.

BEACH PATROL

The Bethany Beach Patrol is a United States Lifesaving Association Advanced Certified Agency that provides services such as ocean rescue, first responder care and public service. The beaches are patrolled from 10am to 5pm Monday through Friday and 9:30am to 5:30pm on weekends and holidays starting on Memorial Day Saturday through Labor Day Monday. After Labor Day Monday and through the remainder of September, the beaches are patrolled on weekends only from 10am to 5pm.

- Ride a bicycle on the boardwalk from May 15th through September 30th except between the hours of 6am to 9am.
- Bicyclists are to travel in the same direction as a motor vehicle, comply with all laws as those of motor vehicles, and are to use bike lanes where provided. Bicyclists are to park bikes at bike racks positioned throughout Town and strongly urged to secure their bike with a locking device.

COURTESY RULES

On the Beach:

- **Enjoy the Shade:** Standard upright umbrellas and baby tents (up to 3' high x 4' wide x 5' long) are welcome! Please ensure they are secure without extending wires or ropes.
- **Smoke-Free Fun:** Smoking and vaping are permitted only in designated areas.
- **Safe Play:** Ball games, object tossing, kites, and fishing are allowed outside of lifeguard hours.
- **Keep It Refreshing:** Enjoy beverages responsibly. No alcohol or glass containers permitted.
- **Beach Space for All:** Boats and vehicles should remain off the sand.
- **Seasonal Pet Policy:** Dogs are welcome from October 1 through May 14.
- **Protect Our Shores:** Open fires are not allowed to preserve the beauty of the beach.
- **Leave No Trace:** Please dispose of trash properly and help keep our beach clean.
- **Beach Hours:** Open to the public from 5 am to 1am daily.
- **Rest at Home:** Sleeping on the beach is not permitted from 10pm to 8am.
- **Sand Safety:** Please avoid digging large holes for everyone's safety.

On the Boardwalk:

- **Seasonal Pet Policy:** Dogs are welcome on the boardwalk from October 1 through May 14.
- **Bike-Friendly Hours:** Enjoy cycling daily from 6am to 9am.
- **Smooth Strolling:** For safety, roller skates, skateboards, motorbikes, and motorcycles are not permitted.
- **Keep It Beautiful:** Please use trash bins and keep our boardwalk clean.
- **Play It Safe:** To prevent accidents, tossing objects and flying kites are not allowed.
- **Alcohol-Free Zone:** Enjoy the boardwalk responsibly without alcoholic beverages.
- **Youth Safety Curfew:** A curfew is in effect for juveniles from 11:00 pm to 5:00 am.

Parking and More

The parking season in the Town of Bethany Beach runs from May 15th through September 15th.

There are approximately 1,000 Pay-to-Park spaces with FREE 15-minute parking spaces spread throughout downtown. More than 700 spaces are reserved for designated permit holders.

Please do not park in driveways, across sidewalks, in bike paths, or next to **yellow** markings. Do not park your vehicle with any part extending into a yellow line. These regulations are enforced.

Payment for vehicles with an accessible plate or permit is required from May 15th through September 15th.

The side streets west of Atlantic Avenue where “RESIDENTIAL and or BUSINESS Permit Required” signs are posted; are not Pay-to-Park spaces.

Electric Vehicle Charging Stations: There are eight Level 2 EV charging stations and each station is equipped with two charging cords so that two EVs can charge simultaneously. The chargers are universal so all makes and models can utilize the service. There is a fee, and the parking spaces are Pay-to-Park and first come first serve for electric or gasoline powered vehicles.

Scooter Parking: Scooter parking is free. Please see the Parking Map for areas and locations.

PAY-TO-PARK SPACES:

Pay-to-Park spaces are \$4 per hour and are nonrefundable. Enforced from 10am to 8pm or 10 am to 11pm, depending on location. Garfield Parkway has a 2-hour time limit. Please review the signage where and when you are parking. Some Beach Lots are “Head-In” parking only and are marked as such.

Three ways to pay:

ParkMobile, Pay Station, Digital 1-,3-,5-, & 7-Day Permits and all are nonrefundable.

• ParkMobile.

Ensure to select the correct ParkMobile Zone in Bethany Beach, DE.

- Text “PARK” to 77223 or
- Download the App or
- Pay on the web.

• Pay Station – Pay-by-Plate.

All accept credit / debit cards and most accept quarters.

1. Enter license plate numbers & letters into kiosk.
2. Press “OK”.
3. Fully insert then remove payment card (Mag stripe facing down and to the right).
4. Follow prompts.
5. Display receipt on dash.

- **Digital 1-, 3-, 5-, or 7-Day Permit** (not valid on Garfield Parkway). Visit www.townofbethanybeach.com > Visitors > Parking > Public Parking – Pay-to-Park > Daily Digital Permit Purchase or scan the QR code below. You must create an account and can change out vehicles.



RESIDENT PARKING PERMITS

Resident and Resident Side Street Parking Permits are for home and property owners within the Town of Bethany Beach.

The “RESIDENT” permits are valid only in beach lots east of Atlantic Avenue and on residential streets marked with “RESIDENTIAL Permit Required” signs.

Resident “SIDE STREET” permits are only valid on east – west streets marked with “RESIDENTIAL Permit Required” signs. They are not valid in any Pay-to-Park spaces. Please see the map on the reverse side for additional information.

BUSINESS PARKING PERMITS

Licensed businesses in downtown Bethany Beach (east of Route 1) are eligible to apply for three types of Business Parking Permits: Premier, Gold and Business Employee.

For details on Business Parking Permits, please review the application or the map on the town website.

Business Employee Parking Permits are valid only on side streets.
